Hard skills are **measurable, teachable, and job-specific abilities** — the technical foundation of any career.

Examples

Coding in Python, data analysis, operating machinery, or fluency in a second language

Degrees, certifications, and technical tests

Personal Attributes

Soft skills define **how you interact** with others — not what you know, but how you behave.



Learned Through Experience

Not taught from a textbook — they grow through **real-world practice** and reflection.



Essential for Leadership

Critical for **conflict resolution, collaboration,** and leading teams effectively.

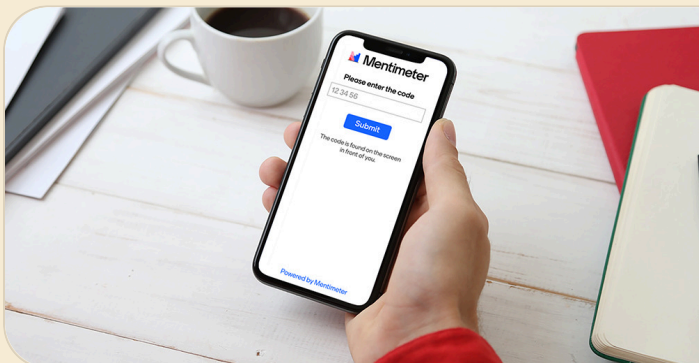

Practice

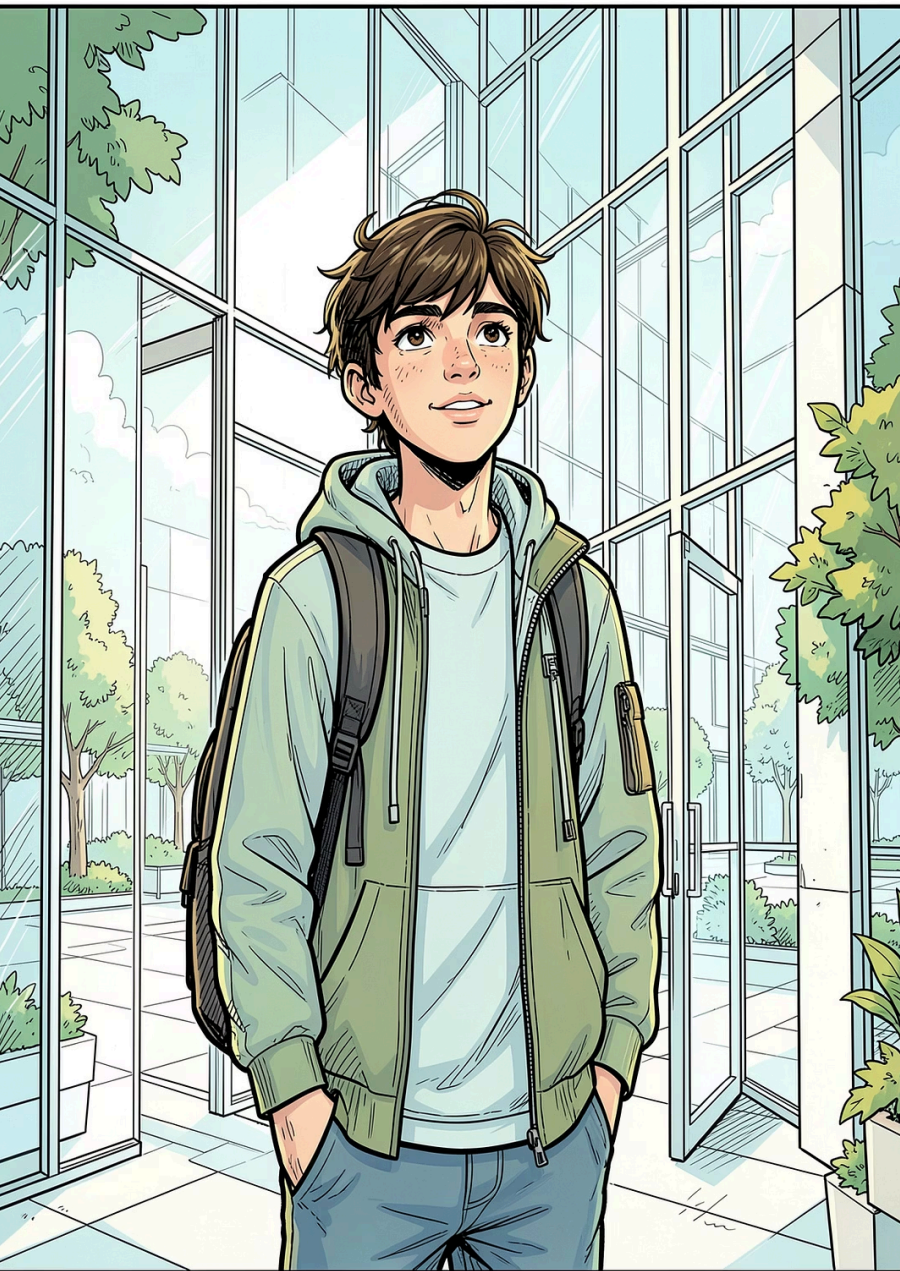
Seek feedback, practice active listening, and **embrace new responsibilities**.
